This state-of-the-art program is designed to provide group instruction to foster and adoptive parents to build the skills necessary to meet the needs of youth who have moderate to serious emotional and behavioral health challenges. Although geared to address issues faced by teens, general principles should be applied to parenting children of all ages. Training begins with a comprehensive understanding of the effects of trauma on the brain and ongoing discussions address how to better meet the needs of youth impacted by trauma while meeting your own needs as a caregiver. By registering for this training, you are committing to actively participate virtually on camera and microphone during 7 weekly zoom meetings and through outside reading and self-assessment.
