Training funds for family members of persons with a disability

Each year Illinois allocates training funds to families of persons with a disability to attend training related to the family member's disability. Only individuals, not agencies or organizations, may apply. The amount of funds available and eligibility guidelines may change each state fiscal year. The Early Intervention Clearinghouse maintains a free lending library consisting of books, journals and DVDs related to early childhood, parenting and young children with special needs.
